AN ORDINANCE OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING DMC 4.15.051, CONTAINER VANS, TO RECLASSIFY CONTAINER VANS AND SIMILAR PROPERTY AS REAL PROPERTY.

Section 1. Classification. This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Adoption of section. DMC 4.15.051, Container Vans, is adopted to read as follows:

4.15.051 Container Vans.

For the purpose of assessing, levying, and collecting taxes, all container vans and similar property are classified as real property.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be made effective with the March 28, 2008 valuations.



WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has funds available that would help the City of Dillingham upgrade the emergency fire alarm system at the Dillingham Middle/High School; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to the terms and conditions of Grant No. 08-DC-258;



WHEREAS, AS 29.45.200 sets out the requirements governing the Board of Equalization; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Equalization members will be a portion of the City Council for hearing any appeals from determination of the city assessors; and




WHEREAS, the City Council intends to formally accept the audited financial statements by this action;

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT THE FLOOD AND MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS AN OFFICIAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF DILLINGHAM.

WHEREAS the City of Dillingham, Alaska has experienced repetitive disasters that have damaged commercial, residential and public properties, displaced citizens and businesses, and presented general public health and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS the community has prepared a *Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan* that outlines the community's options to reduce overall damage and impact from natural hazards; and

WHEREAS the *Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been reviewed by community residents, business owners, and federal, state and local agencies; and has been revised to reflect their concerns;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:


1. The *Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of the City of Dillingham.
2. The Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Team will coordinate the implementation of the Plan's recommendations to the best of their ability given the City of Dillingham's established priorities and funding limitations.
3. The Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Team will establish a plan of action for the following action items recommended by the *Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*.
4. The Flood and Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Team Leader shall convene the hazard mitigation planning as needed to review the plan and suggest changes for the next update. The planning group shall monitor implementation of the plan and shall submit a written progress report to the City of Dillingham.
