RESOLUTION NO. 2009-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BENNETT ENTERPRISES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH BOAT RAMP AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS AT THE SMALL BOAT HARBOR.

WHEREAS, a request for bids to construct the north and south boat ramps, parking and rip rap near the north ramp was issued In March 2008; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received for the projects in April 2008 with Bennett Enterprises, LLC the low bidder for both ramps; and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham City Council approved a contract with Bennett Enterprises, LLC for the construction of a new north ramp at the Small Boat Harbor in Resolution No. 2008-17; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has successfully obtained additional project funds from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation Municipal Harbor Facility Grant (\$195,000) and the Denali Commission Transportation Grant (\$215,000) that will allow completion of the total project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Bennett Enterprises, LLC, in the amount of \$198,875 for the construction of the south ramp at the Small Boat Harbor; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager request a proposal from Bennett Enterprises, LLC for the construction of project Alternate Additives No. 1, north ramp parking lot, and No. 2, rip-rap shore protection and negotiate a change in the work to construct the alternate additives in accordance with the General Conditions of the Contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any shortfall in project funding shall be provided by the State of Alaska Designated Legislative Grant for shoreline bank stabilization (AkDCCED #09-DC-449) in accordance with grant stipulations.
