RESOLUTION NO. 2009-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM BRISTOL BAY REGIONAL SEAFOOD DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,000 TO OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A NEW CRANE IN THE DILLINGHAM BOAT HARBOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham has secured funds to purchase a crane for the Dillingham boat harbor that will give fishermen the ability to load and offload ice and other goods and services easily and more efficiently; and

WHEREAS, the Bristol Bay Regional Seafood Development Association (BBRSDA) has grant funds available to offset costs associated with installation of a new crane in the Dillingham boat harbor effectively aiding in promoting and sustaining economic development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dillingham City Council that:

1. The City accepts Bristol Bay Regional Seafood Development Association funding in the amount of \$23,000.
2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or alternately, the Mayor, to sign all documents on behalf of the City.

ADOPTED by the Dillingham City Council on March 19, 2009.


