RESOLUTION NO. 2009-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING WAIVING THE JOB ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS TO FILL THE POSITION OF INTERIM FINANCE DIRECTOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham was in dire need of a person possessing the skills and leadership ability to fill in as a temporary Finance Director until the position could be filled with a regular, full-time, Finance Director; and

WHEREAS, the City's Personnel Regulations 3.00 Job Announcements and Publicity, states the City Manager will issue job announcements and otherwise publicize vacancies for regular, full-time positions for at least ten working days before the closing date for filing applications. At a minimum the positions may be advertised through the local job service office and radio station(s). Announcements for part-time or temporary positions shall be publicized in whatever manner deemed appropriate by the City Manager. All position openings shall be publicized to City employees by posting a notice in each department five work days prior to public announcements; and

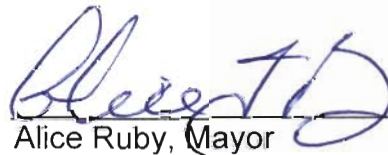
WHEREAS, the Dillingham City Council approved the City Manager's Transition Plan at the March 19, 2009 Council Meeting to hire Ms. Ruth Steele, whose education and experience in accounting, budgeting, committee involvement, supervision of employees, and working with boards of directors, provided the necessary background to perform such duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council approves waiving the job advertising requirements to fill the position of Interim Finance Director.
