RESOLUTION NO. 2009-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVE A CONTRACT WITH BRISTOL ENVIRONMENTAL & ENGINEERING SERVICES CORPORATION FOR THE 2009 WATER PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, at the regular City Council meeting held May 7, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2009-23 approving Bristol Environmental & Engineering Services Corporation (BEESC) to provide contract management services for the 2009 water projects with the stipulation that a waiver of the advertising requirements be brought before the Council at their next meeting; and,

WHEREAS, Dillingham Municipal Code (DMC) 4.30.120, allows waiving of purchase restrictions if the City Council finds that it is not in the public interest to follow the procurement procedures as established for the contracting of professional services, the City Council may, following approval of a resolution stating such, proceed to negotiate with a selected supplier or suppliers for subject services; and,

WHEREAS, the waiver is based on the criteria outlined in DMC 4.30.130, Exemptions, A. 6, restrictions and provisions of this chapter shall not apply to professional services retained on a continuing as opposed to a project basis, e.g. accounting, appraisal, legal and civil engineering services;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to waive the advertising requirements and approve a contract with BEESC for contract management services for the 2009 water projects.


