RESOLUTION NO. 2009-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR A GIS NEEDS ASSESSMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham, Choggiung Limited, and Nushagak Cooperative have had a longstanding interest in having an operational Geographic Information System for the community; and

WHEREAS, the agreements between these partners go back to 1992; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham's Geographic Information System has not been updated since its creation in 1999; and

WHEREAS, there have been more than 100 new subdivisions created, utility changes; and land use changes since then; and

WHEREAS, the state of the database and its components are in need of updating; and

WHEREAS, there are additional components which would benefit the community if they were included in the database; and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Department of Public Safety has had a longstanding goal of having its E911 system integrated with a geographic addressing system, and an updated GIS is fundamental to accomplishing this; and

WHEREAS, the City has the support of Nushagak Cooperatives and Choggiung Limited to conduct the Needs Assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Needs Assessment requires the services of a trained, experienced, GIS professional; and


WHEREAS, Planning Department staff issued a Request for Proposals March 10 to obtain comparable quotes from 4 companies for GIS services; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City wishes to engage the services of Blue Skies Solutions, in the amount of \$16,970 to do a GIS Needs Assessment for the City and its potential partners in the GIS database.
