RESOLUTION NO. 2008-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING RECEIPT OF A GRANT FROM USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$773,150 FOR REPAIR OF THE CITY'S ICE DAMAGED WATER TOWER.**

WHEREAS, Dillingham's 800,000 gallon water tower is the main reservoir for fire protection and domestic water service; and

WHEREAS, during the winter of 2005-2006 the water tower was damaged by prolonged and extreme weather conditions; and

WHEREAS, funding is needed to make the necessary repairs to the damaged water tower;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dillingham City Council that:


1. The City agrees to accept the USDA grant in the amount of \$773,150.
2. The City agrees to contribute \$22,000 in local matching funds and the remaining \$265,250 match will come from a State of Alaska grant.
3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or alternatively the Mayor, to sign all documents on behalf of the City.
